KUALA LUMPUR, Malaysia — The Malaysian International Furniture Fair, a leading furniture trade show in Southeast Asia, has been postponed to July 6-9 and will be held at the Malaysia International Trade & Exhibition Centre and World Trade Centre Kuala Lumpur.

The tradeshow had previously be scheduled for mid-March.
